CAMPING

I. PURPOSE AND SCOPE

This policy is established to protect the health and safety of the campus community and access to and security of University facilities and property. It governs academic and staff employees, students, registered student organizations, organizations not affiliated with the University, and all other individuals on or in University owned or managed property or facilities.

This policy is consistent with Santa Barbara County Ordinances.

II. DEFINITIONS (for the purposes of this policy)

Camp: generally an outdoor area where tents or shelters are set up to live or sleep in for a time; to use camp facilities or paraphernalia.

Camp Facilities: include, but are not limited to tents, huts, or temporary shelters.

Camp Paraphernalia: includes, but is not limited to, tarpaulins, cots, beds, sleeping bags, hammocks, cooking/warming equipment.

Temporary Shelter: a place or structure that gives temporary protection against weather or danger and hasn't been authorized by the University.

University Property: all property and facilities owned or managed by The Regents.

III. POLICY

No person shall camp or erect a temporary shelter on University property.
