OFFSETTING THE SIR FEE

I. PURPOSE AND SCOPE:

The Statement of Intent to Register fee may be offset in special circumstances for apparently full-need EOP students. See Policy 4410. This procedure establishes the appropriate steps to accomplish this fee offset. The payment of the fee is required to complete registration; the fee will be part of a financial aid package usually administered through the UCSB Student Financial Services.

III. PROCEDURE:

Responsibility	Action
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Prospective EOP Student

1. Indicates inability to pay the SIR fee to appropriate EOP office.

EOP Component Head

- 2. Reviews the request to determine financial hardship.
- 3. Verifies probable EOP status.
- 4.Completes the authorization
 form (Attachment A) in
 triplicate:
 - a.Forwards one copy (original)
 to Admissions Office.
 - b.Retains one copy in student's EOP file.
 - c. Sends one copy to student.

5. Files copy of authorization form, coded "SIR not paid" in student's file.
