## UNIVERSITY-ISLA VISTA RELATIONS

## I. REFERENCE:

A. Chancellor Cheadle's letter to Vice Chancellors and Assistant Chancellor, dated September 16, 1970.

## II. POLICY:

This policy sets forth the Chancellor's designation of administrative responsibility for UCSB-Isla Vista relations and names of official campus representatives and spokespersons.

- A. Responsibility for official UCSB-Isla Vista relations, with the exception of law enforcement, is assigned to the Vice Chancellor, Student Affairs, who is the official campus spokesperson and representative. He/she will coordinate the campus' official involvement in Isla Vista, and will give, where warranted, available University support to student, faculty, community, and governmental projects which deal with Isla Vista. In order to achieve maximum communication, cooperation and coordination, all members of the University staff, when dealing with matters which focus on Isla Vista, will be under the supervision of the Vice Chancellor, Student Affairs.
- B. With respect to law enforcement, the responsible campus official and spokesperson, in Isla Vista as well as on campus is the Vice Chancellor, Administrative Services. Insofar as law enforcement matters impact on other Isla Vista community relations, the Vice Chancellors for Administrative Services and Student Affairs will maintain the closest communication and coordination.
